MOSSARIUM CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for purchasing our latest creation line: the FAIRY GARDEN MOTHER MOSSARIUM! You will find that caring for this terrarium is the easiest type we carry.

WATERING AND AIRING OUT

Like our other live, enclosed terrariums, watering will be easy once established. Your home and placement of this terrarium will dictate its watering needs, but it will go home with you, having been recently watered. If the terrarium glass “sweats” all the time, take the lid off for a few hours and let it dry out. It will normally “sweat” an hour or two each day when the moisture levels are balanced.

USING FILTERED OR DISTILLED WATER, you can mist your little world every 2-3 weeks, being mindful of watching the “sweat” to ensure your terrarium’s humidity stays balanced. When this happens, remember it’s still important to open the lid and let your terrarium get a breath of fresh air now and then.

LIGHT

Our moss grows best in indirect sunlight or even artificial light. You’ll want to keep it out of direct sunlight and away from heat sources. You can even try shady spots but if the moss starts to turn brown you should try a spot with a little more light. Don’t worry – the moss will let you know and it will return to its green color once it receives the proper amount of light. Just keep an eye on it.

SPRINGTAILS

What?!? My terrarium has BUGS? Not just any bugs – these are nature’s cleanup crew, making sure your terrarium stays spic and span. Don’t fret. We actually PAID to put them in – they’re that good.

PRUNING

Most of the plants in your terrarium are slow growers, but if they start to grow a little too big, just use scissors and trim them back. If you have a fern in your terrarium, just trim the tall frond at the base. It will grow more. The moss can be trimmed back with scissors, but don’t worry – it’ll be awhile before that happens!

Some people enjoy seeing their terrariums more manicured and some like to let them take on a life of their own. Your choice!
